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In compliance with the Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act (AODA) and resulting regulations, the Joint Accessibility Advisory Committee of Lincoln, West Lincoln, Pelham, Thorold, Niagara-on-the-Lake and Grimsby (JAAC) works to provide consultation and assistance in developing compliance strategies and tools in order to ensure accessibility for its citizens.
